

**CITY OF DARLINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
JANUARY 6, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited. Present at roll call were: Bev Anderson, Cindy Corley, Dave Gough, John Sonsalla and Don Osterday. Excused absence: Steve Pickett. Also present were: Bill McDaniel, Dale Wiegel, Mary Jane Sturtz and Phil Risseeuw.

Motion by Anderson second by Gough that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried. Motion by Sonsalla second by Osterday to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Under new business, discussion was held concerning an Original Alcohol Beverage Retail License application from Dustin K. Thompson, d/b/a The Pool Hall, 200 Christensen Drive, Darlington, WI 53530. A copy of the license application and approval letter from Chief King were included in the agenda packet. It was reported Mr. Thompson is leasing the building formerly operated as Sparky's Spirits, for his pool hall business. After discussion and consideration, motion by Osterday second by Gough to approve the Original Alcohol Beverage Retail License application from Dustin K. Thompson as presented. Motion carried.

A report on nomination papers filed for municipal offices for the 2015 Spring Election was distributed to those present at this meeting. The following people have filed nomination papers for the offices shown: Alderperson, First Aldermanic District – David Gough; Alderperson, Second Aldermanic District – Donald Osterday and Mark Nelson; and Alderperson, Third Aldermanic District – None. The Spring Election will be held on April 7, 2015.

Under reports of committees, Alderperson Osterday reported on the Park and Recreation Committee meeting held December 17, 2015. A copy of the meeting minutes was included in the agenda packet. Alderperson Osterday highlighted several items included in the meeting minutes. And a meeting of the Policies, Procedures and Ordinance Committee was scheduled for Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at 6:00 PM to work on the building inspector and building inspection ordinances.
