

**CITY OF DARLINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**  
***RE-ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING***  
**APRIL 17, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 6:45 PM. Present at roll call were: Steve Pickett, Erin Gallagher, Cindy Corley, Dave Gough and Don Osterday. Excused absence: John Sonsalla. Also present were: Jeremy Williams, Brian Lund and Phil Risseeuw.

Motion by Pickett second by Gallagher that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried.

Council President Dave Gough then administered the Oath of Office to the newly elected Mayor and Alderpersons present at this meeting. At the April 3, 2018 Spring Election, David J. Breunig was re-elected Mayor; Cynthia D. Corley was re-elected Alderperson, First Aldermanic District; Stephen J. Pickett was re-elected Alderperson, Second Aldermanic District; and John A. Sonsalla was re-elected Alderperson, Third Aldermanic District.

Mayor Breunig then asked for nominations for Council President. Motion by Pickett second by Osterday to nominate Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried. Motion by Pickett second by Gallagher to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried.

Discussion was then held concerning the designation of the official newspaper for the City. After discussion and consideration, motion by Gough second by Corley to designate the Republican Journal as the official newspaper for the City of Darlington. Motion carried.

Motion by Pickett second by Gough to designate the following banks, depositories, and investment institutions for deposit of City funds: Huntington Bank – Darlington; First National Bank at Darlington; Town Bank – Darlington; State of Wisconsin Local Government Investment Pool; and Wayne Hummer and Co. Inc. for investment in U.S. Treasury Securities. Motion carried. Bill McDaniel and Dale Wiegel arrived at the meeting at 6:50 PM.

Mayor Breunig then presented his recommendations for Committee appointments. A copy of the committee appointments was included in the agenda packet. Mayor Breunig stated there were some changes in the committee appointments this year; and he thanked the retiring committee members for this previous service. After review and consideration, motion by Gough second by Pickett to approve the committee appointments as recommended by Mayor Breunig. Motion carried. A copy of the approved committee appointments is attached to these meeting minutes for reference.

Mayor Breunig then reported on current projects for new Council members. The following matters were discussed:

- Hwy. 23 reconstruction project. Additional planning for this project is needed prior to the 2020 or 2021 construction period.
- Business park expansion and improvements.
- Swimming pool improvements.
- Jeremy Williams purchased a snowplow truck from Seymour Township.

There being no further business for this meeting, motion by Gough second by Gallagher to adjourn the meeting at 6:54 PM. Motion carried.
