

**CITY OF DARLINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**  
**REORGANIZATIONAL MEETING**  
**APRIL 21, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 6:45 PM. Present at roll call were: Cindy Corley, Dave Gough, Don Osterday and Steve Pickett. Excused absence: John Sonsalla. Also present were: Dale Wiegel, Felix Pereza and Phil Risseeuw.

Motion by Gough second by Pickett that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried.

Mayor Breunig then administered the Official Oath of Office to the newly elected Alderpersons present at this meeting. At the April 7, 2015 Spring Election, Dave Gough was elected Alderperson, First Aldermanic District and Don Osterday was elected Alderperson, Second Aldermanic District. Former Alderperson Bev Anderson did not see re-election for Alderperson, Third Aldermanic District and that position remains vacant.

Mayor Breunig then reported an advertisement was placed in the Republican Journal for Alderperson District Three. A copy of the advertisement was included in the agenda packet. Applicants must submit a resume and list of qualifications to Mayor Breunig by Saturday, April 25, 2015.

Mayor Breunig then asked for nominations for Council President. Motion by Corley second by Pickett to nominate Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried. Motion by Pickett second by Corley to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried. Bill McDaniel arrived at the meeting at 6:50 PM.

Discussion was then held concerning the designation of the official newspaper for the City. After discussion and consideration, motion by Gough second by Pickett to designate the Republican Journal as the official newspaper for the City of Darlington. Motion carried.

Motion by Gough second by Pickett to designate the following banks, depositories, and investment institutions for deposit of City funds: FirstMerit Bank – Darlington; First National Bank at Darlington; Town Bank – Darlington; State of Wisconsin Local Government Investment Pool; and Wayne Hummer and Co. Inc. for investment in U.S. Treasury Securities. Motion carried. Bridget Schuchart and Jeremy Williams arrived at the meeting at 6:53 PM.

Mayor Breunig then presented his recommendations for Committee appointments. A copy of the committee appointments was included in the agenda packet. After review and consideration, motion by Pickett second by Gough to approve the committee appointments as recommended by Mayor Breunig. Motion carried. Mayor Breunig then reported the list of committee appointments will be revised when the vacant Alderperson position is filled. A copy of the approved committee appointments is attached to these meeting minutes for reference.

Mayor Breunig then reported on current projects for new Council members. Comments were made regarding Lafayette County vacating the second floor of the Municipal Building, and what will be done with that space; continuing to participate in League of Wisconsin Municipalities programs; new wastewater treatment plant phosphorus rules; and planning for the Hwy. 23 resurfacing project scheduled for 2020 and 2021.

There being no further business for this meeting, motion by Gough second by Pickett to adjourn the meeting at 6:59 PM. Motion carried.
