

POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES JUNE 6, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairman John Sonsalla at 6:30 PM. Present at roll call were: John Sonsalla, Steve Pickett and Cindy Corley. Absent: None. Also present were: Mayor Dave Breunig, Erin Gallagher, Dave Gough, Bill McDaniel, Jeremy Williams, Valda Ostby and her daughter Connie, Brian Lund and Phil Risseeuw.

Motion by Corley second by Pickett that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried. Motion by Pickett second by Corley to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Under comments from citizens present, Jeremy Williams asked Committee members to consider creating an ordinance requiring horses to wear diaper bags within the city limits. Jeremy stated he has noticed manure piles in city parks, and whenever the horses travel through the city they leave more than just tracks. Attorney McDaniel was instructed to research the matter and report back to the Committee at a future meeting.

Under new business, discussion was held concerning proposed Ordinance 01-2017, An Ordinance Amending Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code of the City of Darlington regarding All-Terrain Vehicles, Utility Terrain Vehicles and Modified Golf Cart Routes. A copy of the proposed ordinance was included in the agenda packet. Attorney McDaniel attended the meeting to present the information and answer questions. This proposed ordinance change originated from a request from the Ostby family. The proposed ordinance adds modified golf carts to the list of vehicles allowed on city streets to access the multi-purpose trail. It also establishes a modified golf cart crossing point upon Wis. State Hwy. 81 and Division St.

Attorney McDaniel then answered questions regarding the proposed ordinance. He stated this ordinance only helps city residents on the north side of the bridge. After discussion and consideration, motion by Pickett second by Corley to approve Ordinance 01-2017, An Ordinance Amending Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code of the City of Darlington as presented, and recommend same to the City Council for approval. Motion carried.

There being no further business for this meeting, motion by Corley second by Pickett to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 PM. Motion carried.
