

CITY OF DARLINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
AUGUST 2, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited. Present at roll call were: Dave Gough, John Sonsalla, Don Osterday, Steve Pickett, Felix Perez and Cindy Corley. Absent: None. Also present were: Brian Lund and Phil Risseuw.

Motion by Pickett second by Perez that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried. Motion by Sonsalla second by Pickett to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Under comments from citizens present, Brian Lund reported the grass on the property directly south of his property has not been mowed all season. Doug Lindstrom will be asked to take care of this concern. Alderperson Gough then reported nothing has been done with the rock house on Spring Street since the house fire. Mike Reuter will be asked to look into that concern. And Alderperson Corley asked if the well has been filled at the old pump house on W. River Street. Jeremy Williams will be asked about that concern.

Under unfinished business, Alderperson Gough suggested another meeting of the Property and Insurance Committee should be held to discuss what to do with the second floor of the Municipal Building. And it was suggested to hold another meeting of the Policies, Procedures and Ordinance Committee to discuss matters tabled at the last meeting of that Committee. Mayor Breunig then stated both meetings will be held prior to the August 16, 2016 Council meeting.

Under new business, the following July, 2016 vouchers were presented for review and approval: City vouchers #37390 thru #37475 in the amount of \$90,970.15; Direct deposit payroll vouchers #6201 thru #6365 in the amount of \$99,861.35; Water Dept. vouchers #5443 thru #5455 in the amount of \$56,024.57; Sewer Dept. vouchers #6236 thru #6250 in the amount of \$23,126.20; and Library vouchers #5297 thru #5302 in the amount of \$14,490.47. Motion carried.

Under reports of committees, Mayor Breunig reported on the Finance and Personnel Committee meeting held prior to this Council meeting. He stated at that meeting eleven applications for the Park and Recreation Director position were reviewed; and six applicants were selected to interview for the position. Alderperson Gough reported the Police Department softball game and brat feed is being postponed one week due to the hot weather predicted for this Thursday. The event will now be held on August 11, 2016. And Mayor Breunig encouraged those present to vote at the Partisan Primary scheduled for Tuesday, August 9, 2016.

There being no further business for this meeting, motion by Perez second by Osterday to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 PM. Motion carried.
