

**CITY OF DARLINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS**  
**REORGANIZATIONAL MEETING**  
**APRIL 16, 2013**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 6:45 PM. Present at roll call were: Cindy Corley, Dave Gough, John Sonsalla, Don Osterday, Steve Pickett and Bev Anderson. Absent: None. Also present was: Phil Risseeuw.

Motion by Anderson second by Gough that the meeting notice and agenda were properly posted. Motion carried.

Mayor Dave Breunig then administrated the Official Oath of Office to the newly elected Alderperson present at this meeting. At the April 2, 2013 Spring Election, Dave Gough was elected Alderperson, First Aldermanic District; Don Osterday was elected Alderperson, Second Aldermanic District; and Bev Anderson was elected Alderperson, Third Aldermanic District.

Mayor Breunig then asked for nominations for Council President. Motion by Corley second by Sonsalla to nominate Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried. Motion by Anderson second by Pickett to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Dave Gough for Council President. Motion carried.

Discussion was then held concerning the designation of the official newspaper for the City. After discussion and consideration, motion by Gough second by Anderson to designate the Republican Journal as the official newspaper for the City of Darlington. Motion carried.

Motion by Gough second by Pickett to designate the following banks, depositories, and investment institutions for deposit of City funds: Citizens Bank – Darlington; First National Bank at Darlington; Talmer Bank and Trust – Darlington; State of Wisconsin Local Government Investment Pool; League of Wisconsin Municipalities Wisconsin Investment Pool; and Wayne Hummer and Co. Inc., for investment in U.S. Treasury Securities. Motion carried.

Mayor Breunig then presented his recommendations for Committee appointments. A copy of the committee appointments was included in the agenda packet. After review and consideration, motion by Gough second by Sonsalla to approve the committee appointments as recommended by Mayor Breunig. Motion carried. A copy of the approved committee appointments is attached for these meeting minutes for reference. Jeremy Williams arrived at the meeting at 6:50 PM.

Mayor Breunig then reported on current projects for new Council members. He thanked several people for their work on recent city projects. And he stated with the new business coming to the business park, the Galena Street sewer main replacement project will now enter the planning stage.

There being no further business for this meeting, motion by Sonsalla second by Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 PM. Motion carried.
