

**MINUTES FROM THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR YEAR 2014 BUDGET
FOR THE CITY OF DARLINGTON HELD DECEMBER 3, 2013**

The Public Hearing was called to order by Mayor Dave Breunig at 6:45 PM. Present at the hearing were: Mayor Breunig, Steve Pickett, Bev Anderson, Cindy Corley, Dave Gough, John Sonsalla, Don Osterday, Tallitha Reese and Phil Risseeuw.

The Notice of this Public Hearing was published in the November 14, 2013 edition of the Republican Journal. The City of Darlington 2014 budget calls for total revenues of \$2,301,335.00; and total expenditures of \$2,301,070.00; and includes a tax levy of \$969,717.00. If this budget is approved, the mill rate will be \$29.06 per \$1000 assessed value; which is \$0.57 higher than the previous year's mill rate.

Mayor Breunig then reported on several items included in the 2014 budget. The 2014 budget does qualify for additional shared revenue under the expenditure restraint program. Phil Risseeuw and the department heads were then complimented on their work on the 2014 budget.

No one from the public attended this public hearing. Mayor Breunig then closed this Public Hearing at 6:53 PM.
